Minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting of Bilbrough Parish held on Tuesday, 14^h May 2019

1. Public Session

1. Parking on Back Lane. The increase in traffic, particularly at the top end is causing problems. Residents and visitors are asked to consider other users when parking their cars in the road.
2. A request was made by a member of the public to ask residents to remember that Bilbrough is a 'dark village' and to consider others when lighting up their property at night. It was suggested that bright external lights should be turned off by 9 pm.
3. A request was made to address the maintenance issues of the Playing Fields. This is being dealt with as a matter of urgency and is covered in the AGM agenda.
4. A request was made for an update on the signage into Bilbrough Services. This is covered in the AGM agenda.
5. A comment was made about vegetation growing onto the footpaths making it difficult for users to stay on the footpath. Residents are asked to cut back vegetation that encroaches over the footpaths.
6. An update was requested regarding the status of the extension of the double yellow lines along Cat Lane. These have been shelved as a result of an objection. The order has to go through NY Highways who are reluctant to risk being set back again. Some members of the council were reluctant to agree to an extension.
